Dear Parents and Guardians

Learning Support

I am delighted that your child will be joining us in September. To ensure a smooth transition into Trent, it is important for us to know whether your child has ever had an assessment for any type of specific learning difficulty, such as dyslexia, dyspraxia, dyscalculia, ADD or ADHD, ASD (including Asperger's Syndrome) or any other speech or literacy difficulty. The assessment may have been carried out by a specialist teacher, an educational psychologist or a health professional. If this is the case, could you please send a copy of the report to me; I need the information so that I can alert teaching staff to your child's individual needs.

It would also be important for us to know if your child has received Learning Support at Ockbrook School, if they have had any informal interventions such as 1:1 subject-specific support, and/or if they are colour blind (this can have implications in subjects like geography).

Individual tuition by specialist teachers is available at Trent College, and is charged as an additional school fee of £44.35 per 50 minute lesson. If you would like any further information about this, or about any other aspect of our Learning Support provision, please do not hesitate to contact me before the end of term on Friday 2nd July.
