Our All-inclusive Fees

At The Elms we attempt, as far as possible, to include all elements of your child's general education in the fee so that parents are aware of the total cost. Therefore, unlike many other schools, we do not make any additional charges for the following:

- School lunches
- Morning snacks of fruit and milk for Infants
- Morning care before school from 8.00am 8.30am
- Two after school clubs per week for Years 3 6 between 3.40pm and 5.00pm (Dance, Arts & Crafts, Journalism, Skills, Performance Arts, Swimming etc)

Registration Fee and Deposit

Registration Fee £60 (this is non-refundable and guarantees assessment for a place at The Elms).

Deposit £200 (this is refundable in the final school bill when leaving The Elms).

Breakfast Club and After School Care

Morning care from 8.00-8.30am is included in fees. Should you wish for your child to join us for a supervised hot breakfast from 7.30-8.00am this is available at an additional cost of £3.50 per day.

After School Care is charged from 4.00-6.00pm where your child can take part in fun, supervised activities along with a drink and snack for £2.50 (per half hour or part of). A charge of £2.00 will be added for each sibling (per half hour or part of). For children with us after 5.00pm a light snack of sandwiches and fruit will be provided.

School Bus Services

The aim of the The Elms bus service is to provide quality and reliable school transport for all who require it at a reasonable cost. The Elms is delighted to offer these bus services in partnership with Skills of Nottingham. Our Elms staff also greet children when they arrive at school in the morning, and will escort them safely across the campus roads. If children are in After School Care, staff will ensure they are on the correct bus when they depart at 5.40pm.
